Trail and Groomer Report: Brian stated hours that have been spent grooming and the money received for those hours. More grooming hours are needed to meet our quota. The groomer fell into a creek. Multiple damages were sustained to the groomer because of this and during the towing process. An insurance check has been received to pay for the damages. Dane is checking to make sure that the claim is not closed if the insurance check is cashed. D&D may find more damages once they start the repair process. Gene Frederickson said that he wants to close the trail to Round About for the remainder of the year. A trail closed sign will be put up on that part of the trail. There are 219 gallons of fuel at the farm that can be used for refueling. The fuel can be purchased from the farm cheaper than refueling somewhere else. The idea is to groom in shorter loops from the farm and when fuel is needed, go back to the farm. Carl Bowers Jr. was made a lifetime member.

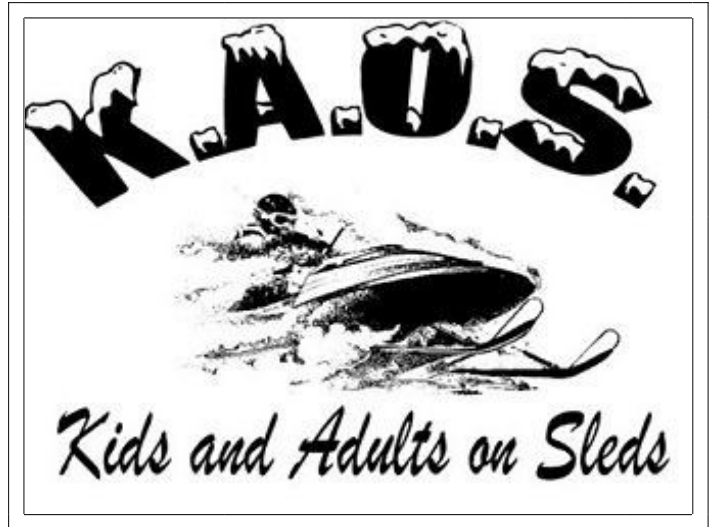
